## **Activity #1 Coastal Environment Excursion**

Year 2 will be visiting the '**Coastal Environmental Centre**', which is situated at North Narrabeen. This excursion will complement our story path unit, 'The Great Barrier Reef'. Students will have hands on experiences at exploring and investigating plant and animal life on the rock platform as well as looking at the catchment area and discussing ways in which we can stop pollution getting out into the ocean. An educator will work with each class and provide the students with information all about the rock platform and the catchment.

## **Activity #2 Swimming Scheme**

Each year as a part of our school curriculum, year 2 participate in a swimming scheme. The Department of Education School swimming scheme is an intensive learn to swim program which caters for all levels of swimming ability. It develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival as well as providing stroke correction and training for more proficient swimmers. The Scheme is conducted over two weeks and each daily lesson is 45 minutes.

Instruction will take place at the Warringah Aquatic Centre. The Scheme will continue daily for **two weeks from Monday 17 September until Friday 28 September**. There is no cost for the swimming tuition, however, bus travel and pool entry per day, will cost \$100 for the 10-day scheme, with payment due by 17 Aug.

Please ensure that your child is ready to attend the swimming scheme each day. Children will need to either wear their swimming costume to school under their sports uniform (this is the preferred option due to ease and warmth) or change into it at recess. Children will get changed back into their sports uniform at the aquatic centre after their lesson. Please provide a small healthy snack in a named container for after swimming. Please pack a towel, underpants, goggles, a plastic bag and a swim cap for long hair. Supermarket enviro bags are suitable to carry all their belongings. All items are to be clearly labelled with your child's name. More information will be sent home closer to the date.

### Activity #3 Life Education

All K-4 classes will be participating in the Life Education "Healthy Harold" program as part of our PDHPE curriculum. The van will be at our school from 16-26 October. Each class will be allocated a time to attend a session during this period.

A parent information session will be held on Tuesday 16 October at 9:30am in the Healthy Harold van. All parents are welcome to attend this free session.
